## Why Business Leaders Are Needed Now More Than Ever

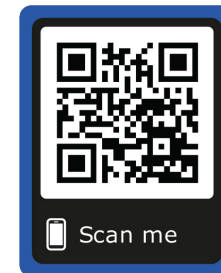
